- Copy of degree certificate(s)
- Passport copy
- Language proficiency

SELECTION CRITERIA

Current (or past) commitment to European ideas and issues (Nature, extent and impact of engagement)

Future commitment to European ideas and issues

- Feasibility of the defined goals
- Congruence between your European focus and selected MCI study program
- Potential impact of your goals
